SCHOOL GOALS – Our Kindergarten to Grade 6 students will...

LITERACY

Consolidate foundational literacy skills (phonological awareness, decoding/fluency, written expression)

Increase engagement in reading/writing, focussing on student *choice and voice*

Strengthen ability to generate, organize and revise creative and critical ideas

LITERACY STRATEGIES

Guided practice to differentiate learning needs

Build staff capacity in effectively using assessment data to identify/monitor/close gaps in learning

Consistent use of research-based resources to support teaching/learning/ assessment through digitally enhanced opportunities

Timely, descriptive feedback related to learning goals & co-created success criteria

NUMERACY

Consolidate foundational number sense/numeration skills

Improve student ability to understand what is being asked in **problem solving** questions

Improve ability to clearly communicate math thinking

Develop positive mindset around math learning

NUMERACY STRATEGIES

Number Talks

Modelled, shared & guided teaching of problem solving strategies to communicate math thinking in multiple ways

Rich, authentic instructional tasks with multiple entry points

Ongoing **anticipation**, **monitoring** & **consolidation** of student learning

Timely, descriptive feedback related to learning goals & co-created success criteria

SCHOOL CLIMATE

Improve self-regulation skills

Increase competence in social problem solving & conflict resolution

Strengthen **positive attitude** on importance of **DPA** to support overall wellness

Increase sense of belonging & positive community

Deepen understanding & inclusion of local Indigenous Education

SCHOOL CLIMATE STRATEGIES

Early identification & ongoing intervention of socio-emotional & self-regulation needs

School-wide focus on **Zones of Self- Regulation**, **Mindfulness**, **problem solving strategies** and whole school language

Restorative, MENDing focus for intervention and progressive discipline

Increase focus on parent/guardian communication and building welcoming culture that engages partnerships
